A look at current budget information and project what can happen. Only looking at the General Fund. First budget revision shows an increase of \$471,635 in revenue due to Feceral Pandemic Relief funding, revised tuition from other districts and student activities. Looking at a 14.04% fund balance on 6/30/2023. Revenue assumptions include 2% in general education aid for 2023-24 and 1% for the remaining years. Maintaining expenditures would result in the fund balance being below the fund balance policy of 8-12% for 2024-25. Federal Pandemic Relief funds end after 2023-24. We currently have 6 staff positions provided with this funding. Looked at the Base Scenario with three options including 1. No staff cuts, 2. Half staff cuts and 3. CARES FTE reduction and no Staff cuts.
