Part 2 (\$1000) of the award will be sent to the recipient after the May 2024 Post meeting and verification of GPA or graduation.

Criteria

Has a parent, grandparent, or close relative that has honorably served in the United States Military.

Is a daughter, son, granddaughter, or grandson of a Post #270 member in good standing.

Has maintained a cumulative grade point average of 2.6/3.0. **Most recent transcript to be included with application.**

Has been enrolled in a post high school education or training program at an accredited community, technical, or four- year college for a minimum of 1 year.

Scholarship must be used for continuing education.
