

# American Legion Post #270 Buffalo, MN 2024 Vocational Scholarship Application

The American Legion Post #270 will be awarding scholarship funds to a graduating senior from the 2024 Buffalo High School graduating class, the recipient will receive a 2-part award that will total \$2000.

Applicants are only eligible for 1 of the 3 scholarships offered by Buffalo Post #270.

The selected recipient must meet the scholarship criteria and complete the application on a timely basis. The successful candidate will be selected by the sitting officers of Post #270 and be asked to attend the May 22, 2024, Post meeting to receive part 1 (\$1000) of their award. Part 2 (\$1000) of the award will be sent to the recipient after the May 2025 Post meeting and verification of GPA.

## Criteria Part 1 of Award

Be a graduating senior of Buffalo High School.

Has maintained a cumulative grade point average of 2.6 in high school. **Transcript to be included with application.**

Has applied or been accepted to a post high school vocational training program at an accredited community or technical institution.

Scholarship must be used for continuing education.

Has a parent, grandparent, or close relative that has honorably served in the United States Military.

## Criteria Part 2 of Award

Continued enrollment in the program entered upon after graduation from Buffalo High School.

Maintains a cumulative grade point average of 2.6/3.0. **Transcript to be provided to the Post #270 scholarship administrator when contacted, May 2025.**

Scholarship must be used for continuing education.
