A. BHS Graduation Requirements, Pam Miller, Director of Teaching and Learning and Mark Mischke, BHS Principal

Graduation requirements are being changed to transition with the change from the 4-period block schedule to the 5-period trimester schedule. Full implementation will take place by 2026-27. An added course requirement in English is either English Literature and Composition or CIS Literature; Social Studies will add Human Geography; Business will add Personal Finance and Phy Ed will reduce the requirement from 1.5 to 1 credit. Work will continue for implementation of the trimester schedule with the 2023-24 school year. The Trimester schedule will require 27.5 out of possible 30 credits for graduation.
