A. Summer Programs, Kim Carlson, Director of Community Education Catolog is online only. Receiving guidance daily regarding youth programs for the summer. Behind the Wheel started today with COVID-19 precautions in place. Classroom instruction will take place through distance learning. KidKare will be open to everyone for the summer and will use the 1:9 ratio and a fee is charged. District Nurses have been updating them every week. Targeted Services will be offered through Distance Learning. Staff have been hired and technology devices can be provided. Opening Doors is providing online opportunities for BINGO, etc.

Discussion – KidKare participation is increasing for the summer. PPE is being provided for the KidKare staff.
