6:00-6:30 p.m. Welcome Back Program - BHS Performing Arts Center (PAC)

- Administration will host a short program introducing the entire teaching staff. Strongly encourage all guests to attend.

6:30-7:00 p.m. Q and A Session with BHS Administration - BHS Performing Arts Center (PAC)

- Teachers will be back in their classrooms for those not attending the Q&A session.

5:00-8:00 p.m. Outside of Doors 6 and 7 (Cafeteria - North Entrances)

- J&J Athletics will be on site for you to purchase items.
- Food Trucks will be on site for you to purchase items.

Main Gymnasium:

- Purchase 2024-2025 Activity Passes
 - Activity Passes will be available ONLINE on the School Store through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal mid-to-late August. Cash/check sales will also be available through the Activities Office.
 - Price for Passes:
 - Single BHS Student \$25 (BHS students receive a free T-shirt with their purchase)
 - Single BCMS/Elementary Student \$50
 - Single Adult \$70
 - Family Pass \$155

Cafeteria:

- Zahler Photography will be onsite for school photos
 - This is meant for any 9-11th grade student and any new 12th grade students.
 - Additional school picture days are noted on the reverse side of this document.
- Deposit lunch money & verify your lunch pin# (also available on the student/parent portal)
 - Again, this school year 2024-25, we are joining Minnesota's Free School Meals for Kids program. **All students are allowed one breakfast and one lunch free of charge each day at school.** Meal accounts will need a positive balance to purchase ala carte items.

Although no application is required to receive this free meal benefit, filling out the Application for Educational benefits is still important! Your child(ren) may qualify for other benefits such as: reduced fees for classes and other activities.

BHS Front Atrium and Front Offices:

If using a check as payment, you'll need to use a new check at each station noted (cash or checks only for the items below, please)

- Purchase locks (New=\$5 and Used=\$3)
- Purchase/pick up student parking permits
 - \$100 for the school year (*may be purchased through Parent Portal in advance*).
- Pick up class schedules, if a paper copy is needed (please double check schedules the day of Open House and again the 1st day of class as things may change).
- Register for Parent Portal (bring valid photo ID)
- Connect with our Health Office

- If there is a change in your student's health status during any school year, it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to inform the Health Office of updates.

Library Learning Center (LLC):

- Dedicated Devices
 - Students that would like to use a school owned device must complete the **BHM Schools Device Loan Agreement** and pay for the \$40 Chromecare. This can be done through the Infinite Campus School Store in advance. Once payment is received the devices may be checked out from the Library Learning Commons.

Teachers will be present in classrooms to meet students and families throughout the night. They will not be available during our Welcome Back Program in the PAC (from approximately 5:50-6:40pm).

*Please park in the north lot and enter through the north doors, #6 and #7. Please feel free to contact the BHS main office with any further questions you may have at 763-682-8100.

Important dates to remember for our BHS/Phoenix students and families:

- **Friday, August 9**
 - Student schedules available on the parent/student portal by 4pm
- **Monday, August 12**
 - Fall Sports begin, all proper paperwork must be in before students can practice.
 - All students are welcome to claim lockers in their designated locker bays during office hours, 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday - Thursday (Phy Ed lockers will NOT be available until the first day of class). All students are expected to have a locker. Locks may be re-used from BCMS/BHS. Locks are available for purchase at BHS in the main office. (\$5/new and \$3/used - cash/checks only)
- **Wednesday, August 28**
 - BHS Open House from 5-8 p.m.
 - ***Picture Day during Open House**
- **Tuesday, September 3**
 - Class begins for incoming 9th graders at 8:50 a.m.
- **Wednesday, September 4**
 - Class in session for all BHS/PLC students at 8:50 a.m.
 - ***Picture Day** at BHS in the morning hours for those that didn't have their photo taken at Open House (grades 9-11 and any **new** 12th grade students)
- **September 16-20**
 - BHS Homecoming Week, additional information will be shared with students as it gets closer.
- **October 9**
 - BHS Picture Retake Day, generally complete by 10:00 am

***BHS Picture days, additional information:**

Picture forms are included in this mailing and online ordering is available on our BHS website. We ask that all students in grades 9-11 have their photo taken for student ID reasons - there's no obligation to purchase photos. Students in grade 12 that are new to our building will also be asked to have their photo taken, again for a student ID. Senior students that would like to have their Zahler photo be used as their senior photo in the yearbook must attend one of the photo sessions stated.
