BHM Schools unites the communities of Buffalo, Hanover, Montrose, and surrounding townships. Ten schools serve 5,700 students, whose test scores at every grade level significantly outpace state averages.

Personalization and innovation drive our learning. Step inside any BHM school and you'll see personalized learning in action and abundant in-school and extracurricular opportunities instilling creativity and encouraging students to aim high. From state-of-the-art technology to our STEM program, from multi-age/looping classrooms to the high school arts magnet program, we are preparing students for successful futures in a rapidly changing world.

The personal relationships staff build with students reinforce mutual respect and make learning relevant. In fact, a recent survey showed

EARLY LEARNING Options Begin at Birth

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) serves families with children from newborn to kindergarten. Options include parent classes, parent/child classes, an annual family fair, summer events and preschool classes. Our ECFE preschool classes for children ages three to five have earned Minnesota Parent Aware's Four-Star Rating. If intervention is needed, special education services are available at birth and can continue through age 21.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS Small Class Sizes, Abundant Options

BHM Schools takes pride in the number of opportunities offered to elementary-age students, who benefit from class sizes that are smaller than most surrounding districts, especially in grades K–2. Parkside, Hanover, Northwinds and Montrose Elementary School of Innovation serve their respective neighborhoods. Families may choose Discovery with its multi-age/looping classrooms or Tatanka, offering a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) magnet program. **The Quest program** provides accelerated learning opportunities for the top 2–3% of students in grades 2–9 with grades 2–5 served at Parkside

MIDDLE SCHOOL Small Groups, Big Opportunities

Buffalo Community Middle School students work collaboratively in grade-level teams to promote a small group atmosphere in a school with big opportunities. All grade 6 students take coursework in technology, art, and communication, taught through the lens of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math). AVID, Bison Binders and students' first-hour Prime Time class build organizational skills and improve academic performance. Students also benefit from top-notch music instructors, numerous vocal and instrumental options, and extracurricular choices in sports, academics and the arts.

HIGH SCHOOL Preparing for Success

Buffalo High School (BHS) is one of the state's most outstanding schools. More than 1,800 students in grades 9–12 have access to career and college-level courses that far exceed other districts. BHS students can earn college credits without sacrificing the high school experience through a unique set of courses that align with the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum. We boast an exemplary graduation rate of 96%.

The Arts Magnet Program is a school within the high school offering arts-enriched core classes and a total immersion in a variety of arts classes.


Phoenix Learning Center serves students who thrive in an alternative high school setting.


