MN's one to four star rating system, a free service, measures best practices identified by research that help children succeed. Public school preschools, Early Childhood Special Education, Head Start, child care and non-public preschool programs can apply for this rating. Scholarships may be awarded to qualifying families whose children attend MN Parent Aware star-rated programs. The scholarships, up to \$7,500, can be used for program fees and costs, and/or to enhance or expand services. Spring Into Preschool is a preschool class for our youngest learners, 2.5 years by September 1, 2019, who would enjoy a preschool experience designed just for them. Parents drop off your preschooler each Thursday for 28 sessions. For the parent, on designated dates, participation in a parent group led by a Parent Educator is held. Sibling care is available with prior registration.

Our first session is a family day in which you'll have an opportunity to meet the staff and run through the daily schedule.

A \$50 registration fee will reserve a place for your child in the class. The registration fee is NON-refundable. Tuition Scholarships may be available for children age 3 years by September 1, 2019.

Early Childhood Screening

Do you have a child between the ages of 3-5 years old?

Early Childhood Screening allows you to check your child's overall development in a 1 hour appointment. The state of Minnesota now recommends that all children be screened before their 4th birthday. In order for your child to start kindergarten in any Minnesota public school, you will need to provide your child's Early Childhood Screening records and immunization record. Note: Screening is required within 90 days of beginning ECFE preschool.

Ready Set Grow Preschool

4 years old by September 1, 2019

(Class Max 18)

The fantastic world of four and five year old children, that special year before Kindergarten will focus on friendships, skill building and age appropriate academic experiences. Our teachers use Creative Curriculum, Second Step, Handwriting Without Tears and TS Gold to prepare and assess the growth and development of this age group. Children will participate in experiences that focus on language development, math and science thinking. The child will explore the arts, communication, letter knowledge and literacy through age appropriate activities, in both large and small group formats. Our preschool classes are integrated with ECSE, partnering to create an age appropriate experience for child of all abilities. Required parent involvement activities allow you to meet other preschool parents, explore new parenting strategies, or volunteer in your child's classroom. Three, four, or five day preschool options are available. *Please Note:* Parents are responsible for transportation to and from preschool.


