

# **Introducing the Pyramid Model**



#### What is Pyramid Model?

The **Pyramid Model** is a framework for supporting the social and emotional development of our children. The goal of the **Pyramid Model** is to create an environment of success by designing classrooms that promote engagement in learning and by building positive relationships among children, families, and staff. In our use of the Pyramid Model, our classroom staff work together to ensure all children understand behavior expectations, receive instruction in social skills, and those children who demonstrate a need for additional support, receive individual supports from the teaching team.

The more socially skilled children are, the more likely they are to succeed in school. Because this is so important for your child, we are implementing the **Pyramid Model** in our Ready Set Grow, KidKare and Early Childhood Special Education programs.

# Spring Into Preschool (2.5 - 3.5 Years)



### **Spring Into Preschool**

2 years 6 months of age by September 1, 2020 (Class Max 9)

**Spring Into Preschool** is a preschool class for our youngest preschoolers who would enjoy a preschool experience designed just for them. Parents drop off your preschooler each Thursday for 28 sessions. For the parent, on selected dates, required participation in a parent group is led by a parent educator. Sibling care is available with prior registration.

Our first session is a Family Day (see information below) in which you will have an opportunity to meet the staff and run through the daily schedule.

A \$50 <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee will reserve a place for your child in the class. Tuition scholarships may be available for children age 3 years by September 1, 2020.

Our teachers use Creative Curriculum, Second Step, and the Pryamid Model Framework to prepare age appropriate activities. Children will participate in activities that focus on language, social/emotional development and the arts. Our preschool classes are integrated with Early Childhood Special Education, partnering to create an age appropriate experience for child of all abilities. Required parent involvement activities allow you to meet other preschool parents, explore new parenting strategies, or volunteer in your child's classroom. *Please Note:* Parents are responsible for transportation to and from preschool.

A \$50 <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee will reserve a place for your child in the class of your choice. Tuition scholarships may be available. There is a 2-week notice required and a charge to accommodate changes in registration status.

# Early Childhood Screening

#### Ages of 3-5 years old

Early Childhood Screening allows you to check your child's overall development in a 1-hour appointment. The state of Minnesota now recommends all children be screened before their 4th birthday. In order for your child to start kindergarten in any Minnesota public school, you need to provide your child's Early Childhood Screening records and immunization record. Note: Screening is required within 90 days of beginning ECFE preschool.

### Ready Set Grow Preschool

#### 4 years old by September 1, 2020

(Class Max 19)

The fantastic world of four and five year old children, that special year before Kindergarten will focus on friendships, skill building and age appropriate academic experiences. Our teachers use Creative Curriculum, Second Step, Handwriting Without Tears, the Pryamid Model Framework and TS Gold to prepare and assess the growth and development of this age group. Children will participate in experiences that focus on language development, math and science thinking. Your child will explore the arts, communication, letter knowledge and literacy through age appropriate activities, in both large and small group formats. Our preschool classes are integrated with Early Childhood Special Education, partnering to create an age appropriate experience for children of all abilities. Required parent involvement activities allow you to meet other preschool parents, explore new parenting strategies or volunteer in your child's classroom. Two, three, four or five day preschool options are available. *Please Note:* Parents are responsible for transportation to and from preschool.

A \$50 <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee will reserve a place for your child in the class of your choice. Tuition Scholarships may be available. There is a 2-week notice required and a charge to accommodate changes in registration status.
