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



Hi BHM Families,


Journeys (Age Birth- 6 years)



Screening consists of the following components:

- Cognitive Development
- Large and small muscle development
- Language and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
- Vision and hearing
- Height and weight
- Health history
- Immunization Review
