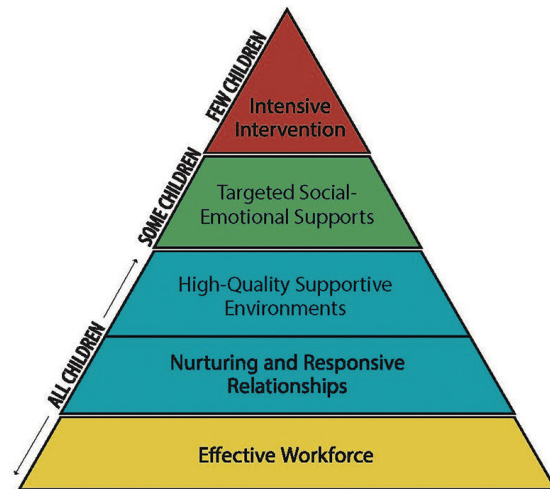

## From the Coordinator.....

Research has shown that the skills your child needs to be successful in the future are social and emotional skills! The more socially skilled children are, the more likely they are to succeed in school. Because this is so important for your child, we are implementing the **Pyramid Model** in our Ready Set Grow, Kid Kare and Early Childhood Special Education programs.

## What is the Pyramid Model?

The Pyramid Model is a framework for supporting the social and emotional development of our children. The goal of the Pyramid Model is to create an environment of success by designing classrooms that promote engagement in learning and by building positive relationships among children, families, and staff. In our use of the Pyramid Model, our classroom staff will work together to ensure that all children understand behavior expectations, receive instruction in social skills, and those children who demonstrate a need for additional support, receive individual supports, from the teaching team.



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## What Happens in a Parent and Child Class...



Class begins with activities for parents and children together.



Parents separate from children for discussion facilitated by a Parent Educator.



Children remain with an Early Childhood Educator for age-appropriate education.

**ECFE is an Early Childhood Family Education and School Readiness program.**

We provide parent education, together with early childhood education, for parents and their children aged birth to kindergarten enrollment. This also includes expectant parents. Parents and children participate in classes, parent discussion groups, home visits, or special events. We are part of Community Education and are funded by a local tax levy, state aid, and fees. Classes are taught by licensed early childhood or parent educators. We believe that “home is the child’s first learning environment and parents are the child’s first and most important teachers.” **To learn more call 763.682.8780.**

**Separating parent group classes for children birth to 5 years by September 1, 2019**

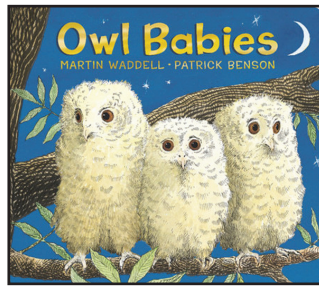

## Early Childhood Screening (ages 3-5 years)

Screening will check your child's overall development. The state of Minnesota recommends all children be screened before their 4th birthday in order to start kindergarten in any Minnesota public school. **Screening is required within 90 days of beginning ECFE preschool.** Call 763.682.8408 or 763.682.8780 to schedule.
