Road Test Procedure Information Sheet

Congratulations! You are now ready to schedule your road test with the State of Minnesota.

- You will schedule the Road Test with the <u>Minnesota Driver and Vehicle Services (DVS)</u>.
 (Community Education cannot schedule road test appointments.)
- Appointments scheduled online at dvs.dps.mn.gov or by calling 651.284.1234. Be aware that appointments
 are scheduled many months in advance. Note: Online DVS only schedules two months out but by phone they
 will schedule further out.
- The permit number from the student's instruction permit is needed to schedule the appointment.

When taking your road test and applying for your provisional license test you need the following 8 items:

- 1. White Card signed by Kim Carlson. Your BTW instructor gives the white card to you after completing 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction.
- 2. Your valid photo instruction permit.
- 3. Current (valid) original copy of your insurance card for the vehicle you will be driving on the road test.
- 4. Your social security number completed on your application.
- 5. The state fee for your provisional license.
- 6. A parent and/or legal guardian to sign your application.
- 7. Parental Curriculum Course Certificate of Completion. (If you attended the Parent/Student Safety meeting).
- 8. Supervised Driving Log.

Helpful information to know before taking your road test:

- Refer to the Minnesota Manual (pages 6-9) <u>or</u> download the manual at **MNDriveinfo.org** to see what is expected on the road test.
- Know and be able to perform the ten safety equipment checks of your vehicle. Refer to pages 7-8 in the manual.
- You must provide your own vehicle (rental vehicles can NOT be used due to lack of insurance coverage by the rental companies).
- The doors must open from both the inside and outside.
- Seat belts must work properly. The headlights, taillights, turn signals, and <u>all</u> brake lights must be in working order.
- Vehicles with dealer license plates used for the road test must have the insurance card.

Reminders during the road test:

- Your headlights <u>must</u> be on (not just the daytime running lights). Do you know how to manually put on your vehicle's headlights? Do you know how to use the climate controls?
- Never do a rolling stop. Make complete stops.
- Right turns should be 1½ to 2 feet from the curb. Pull over like a mini-lane change. Remember to check your blind spot <u>before</u> pulling over.
- PR's (Perceived Risks) will be strictly evaluated. Not **looking** in the proper place at the proper time could be a risk at stake. Four poor PR's will result in a road test failure.
- When applying for your provisional license, you will have the option to become an organ and tissue donor.
