- Math- 3 credits - Required to pass Geometry and Algebra 2
- Social Studies- 3.5 credits - Required Am. Gov't, Am. History, World St. and Econ
- Science- 3 credits - Required Phys. Science, Gen. Biology and Physics or Chemistry
- Phy. Ed.- 1.5 credits
- Health- .5 credits
- The Arts- 1 credit
- Choice credits- 12.5 credits
- Total- 28 Credits Required to Graduate
