Fee: \$465 fee is for 30 hours of classroom instruction, 6 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction AND all classroom materials and supplies. The classroom portion of the fee, \$135, is non-refundable. **Please check for schedule conflicts prior to registration.**

Class Size: Limited to 35.

Class Dates and Times: Classes are held Monday thru Friday, 3-hours per day. A total of 30 hours of classroom instruction must be completed. 100% attendance and promptness is expected. Only one make-up session is offered.

BHM Community Education Classroom Policies Driver Education Program

- 1.) Suspended/truant students may not attend classroom instruction.
- 2.) Students must be in attendance the full 30 hours of classroom instruction (State Law for students under 18 years of age). 30 hours must be completed/passed by the last day of classroom or the makeup class.
- 3.) Students who have tardies and/or absence from one class should plan to attend the scheduled make-up session.
- 4.) We offer one 3-hour make-up session. Students needing more than 3-hours of make-up time will be withdrawn and must repeat thirty hours of the classroom instruction and pay the classroom fee again. **The classroom portion of the fee, \$135, is nonrefundable/transferable.**
- 5.) Students who are absent from one class are expected to have the next class assignment done upon returning to class as well as the assignment due on the day of the absence.
- 6.) Students must bring their class materials (student folder, textbook, workbook, manual, **black pen**, pencil and highlighter) to every class. If the Drive Right textbook is not returned, a \$100 replacement fee will be invoiced.
- 7.) Students need to average 70% or higher on assignments, quizzes and tests (indicating they have successfully completed the coursework) and be registered/paid for BTW with Community Education to receive the BLUE CARD.
- 8.) Students cannot use electronic devices during class.
- 9.) Students absent from one class may not make-up missed videos.
- 9.) Food or drink are not allowed in the classroom or on carpeted areas.
- 10.) There is ZERO TOLERANCE for students with a chemical violation or unlawful action during classroom instruction. Students will be withdrawn from classroom instruction without a refund.
- 11.) Students should adhere to school campus rules.
- 12.) Please help keep the room, hallways and lavatories clean.
- 13.) The need for disciplinary action could result in expulsion from the Drivers Education program.
- 14.) Students should demonstrate a positive and serious attitude for this rigorous classroom instruction.
- 15.) Students must meet all requirements to pass the classroom instruction.
- 16.) Students should depart from the building within 15 minutes after class.

M.S.171.04, subd. 1: The Department of Motor Vehicle shall not issue a driver's license to any person who is under the age of 18 years unless the person had applied for, been issued, and possessed the appropriate instruction permit *for a minimum of six months*.
