Amplified Leadership

In December, our **3rd-5th grade leaders** lead their classroom in discussion surrounding traditions and celebrations. Students were able to discuss traditions and celebrations that are important to their families while also learning about the traditions and celebrations of their classmates. Students were also able to express what traditions/celebrations they are interested in learning more about! This was extended in **January** as our leaders **facilitated discussions** about our **differences**.

They used critical thinking to explore the following questions:

1. In what ways are people different and in what ways are people similar?
2. Why is it important that people have differences?
3. How can we celebrate our differences?
4. If you do not have the same opinion as someone else, how can you handle it?
5. What can teachers do to help you learn more about your classmates?

COMFORTING CORNER WITH MRS. LANDRUS, SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER

When experiencing uncomfortable emotions, negative or worrisome thoughts are often to blame. Some of our students know this negative thinking as having a "story snake". We talk about the need to write a better story to fight our story snakes. One way to do this is by using the High 5 Strategy. Work with your child to identify the negative or worry thought. Then think of 5 positive thoughts RELATED to the situation, sticking up a finger with each thought on one of your hands. Once you reach 5, give your child a high 5! Continue to practice these positive thoughts to help train your child's brain to think of them on their own.
