

Testing Information Sheet

- ***NEW in 2025! The State of Minnesota Department of Public Safety (DPS) has transitioned to an electronic Certificate of Completion system to replace paper completion cards.***
- Certificate of Completion submissions will be entered electronically into the State of Minnesota DPS portal by Community Education staff within 4-7 days of the last classroom session or completing the sixth hour of Behind the Wheel instruction.
- Parents will receive a **Confirmation of Submission** to the email provided to Community Education whenever an e-card is created. **A copy of this confirmation is not needed at the test center appointment.** However, if you choose, you can bring the confirmation copy with you as proof of submission or have access to your email.
- Please allow 7 business days from the end of classroom instruction and/or behind the wheel instruction before your testing appointment to allow staff time to enter student data into the DPS Portal.

Make Appointment for Written Knowledge Permit Test

1. (DPS Preferred) Schedule at the Department of Public Safety Buffalo Exam Station (1006 Commercial Drive), visit **dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs** and select **Schedule Written or Road Test, Driver Services, Class D Knowledge Permit Test.**
2. To schedule at the Wright County Government Center (3650 Braddock Ave NE) visit **co.wright.mn.us** and **scroll down to “Make an Appointment”.**
3. Follow the prompts.

Make Appointment for Road Test Skill Exam

1. Schedule at the Department of Public Safety Buffalo Exam Station (1006 Commercial Drive), visit **dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs** and select **Schedule a Written or Road Test, Driver Services, Class D Road Test First Time.**
2. Follow the prompts
