

Taking the Class D Written Knowledge Test



Schedule an In-Person Appointment

1. Go to **drive.mn.gov**
2. Select **Appointments**, then select **Schedule or Reschedule Road Test or Class D Knowledge Test**
3. Follow the prompts

Come Prepared:

Students should come prepared. Visit the **Need Help?** section on the **drive.mn.gov** website for updates.

- Bring your **Certificate of Enrollment (Blue Card)** proving you completed classroom instruction
- You must be at least 15 years old
- A parent, court-appointed guardian, county-appointed foster parent or the director of the transitional living program you reside in will need to come with to sign and approve your application
- Know your social security number
- Wear/bring a face mask. A health screening may also be required for the student and parent/guardian.
- Bring all required documents
- Bring check, cash or money order to pay any fees, if applicable
