

Schedule an In-Person Appointment

- 1. To schedule at the Wright County Government Center in Buffalo, visit **co.wright.mn.us and scroll down to "Make an Appointment"**. To schedule at a different location, visit **drive.mn.gov** and select **Appointments**.
- 2. Follow the prompts.

Come Prepared:

Student's should come prepared. Visit the **Need Help?** section on the **drive.mn.gov** website for updates.

- Bring your **Certificate of Enrollment (Blue Card)** proving you completed classroom instruction.
- You must be at least 15 years old.
- A parent, court-appointed guardian, county-appointed foster parent or the director of the transitional living program you reside in will need to come with to sign and approve your application.
- Know your social security number.
- Bring all required documents.
- Bring check, cash or money order to pay any fees, if applicable.
