

Class D Written Knowledge Test Information Sheet

Schedule an In-Person Appointment

- 1. To schedule at the Wright County Government Center (3650 Braddock Ave NE) visit **co.wright.mn.us and scroll down to "Make an Appointment"**.
- To schedule at the Department of Public Safety Buffalo Exam Station (1006 Commercial Drive), visit dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs and select Schedule Written or Road Test, Driver Services, Class D Knowledge Exam.
- 3. Follow the prompts.
- 4. The test center will collect the **Blue Card** at your testing appointment.

Be Prepared:

The list below may not be complete or can change. To review what you need at your appointment visit **dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs/license-and- id** or contact the Department of Motor Vehicle Services.

- You must be at least 15 years old.
- Bring your **Certificate of Enrollment (Blue Card)** proving you completed classroom instruction.
- Bring all required documents such as Certified Birth Certificate or Passport and original social security card. Visit **dps.mn.gov/divisions/dvs/license-and- id** for list of approved documents.
- A parent, court-appointed guardian, county-appointed foster parent or the director of the transitional living program you reside in will need to attend with you to sign and approve your application.
- Bring payment to pay any fees, if applicable.
