Everything We Do is for the Good of our Students

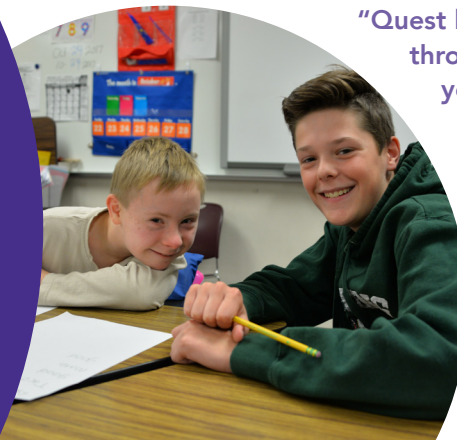
Our students quickly learn that BCMS teachers can be counted on for support. We listen to our parents and youth—to their ideas and needs—and involve them meaningfully in decision-making.

Personalized Learning & Electives

Innovative classes and elective opportunities in tech ed, Family and Consumer Science, physical education, health and technology promote personalized learning. Students also have access to a top-notch music program with many vocal and instrumental options.

Talented & Caring Faculty

Our staff understand the importance of helping students set and achieve their goals. In every classroom at BCMS, every day, you'll see relevant and rigorous curriculum delivered. Our staff are certified experts in their content area, with more than 80% of our teachers having earned their master's degrees.

Unmatched Learning Opportunities

Our school-wide **AVID** program helps students find their passion and prepare for college and careers. All students receive a Bison Binder with a planner and supplies to increase their organizational skill-set.

Quest is an accelerated learning program, serving the top 3-5% of the student body who need more challenge. Students take accelerated English, social studies, math and science classes and mix in with their grade level for music, art, physical education, electives and lunch.

By adding an arts component to the concepts of science, technology, engineering and math (STEAM), BCMS offers 6th grade elective courses with enhancements of **STEAM**. These innovative classes integrate creative expression, inquiry, critical thinking and collaboration into learning. During their first year of middle school, students gain strong foundational skills in technology and engineering processes that promote understanding of real life experiences.

Specialized Education

We pay attention to the needs of our students. A system of academic and behavioral interventions makes sure that those who need help get it.

Our special education services are second to none. We offer specific programming and support for students with different abilities and needs. Students are placed in the most appropriate setting to meet their educational needs. In addition, many students have the opportunity to work with an 8th grade mentor to help develop social skills and build relationships.

Exceptional Facilities

Because BCMS was once a high school, our students benefit from exceptional indoor and outdoor spaces. Oversized science, music and art classrooms allow students the space to be creative and grow. We also have a pool, two gyms, a football field, track, two new health classrooms, and green spaces for baseball, softball, soccer and lacrosse.

Smart Technology

BCMS uses technology to support high quality instruction and student learning. We are a leader in integration, with sophisticated computer labs, Chromebooks, SMART Boards, iPads, laptops, LCD projectors and wireless access points available throughout the building to support learning. Increased access to technology provides our students with opportunities to process ideas, collaborate with their peers and extend learning beyond the classroom walls.



Engaged Parent Community

A parent advisory council builds community relationships and plays a key role in deciding the future direction for BCMS. The group provides input on such topics as conferences, school safety and methods of communication to improve our middle school culture and climate.

BCMS is on a quarter system, providing students with opportunities to take a variety of courses throughout the year.

Each day begins with **Prime Time**, when students focus on character education, positive relationships, study skills and strategies. There are six classes daily.

The BCMS activities program is designed to help students have fun, develop new friendships, advance skill levels, and have challenging and rewarding experiences. Our coaches and advisors share a holistic philosophy about the well-being of the middle school child.

7th & 8th Grade Sports

All 7th and 8th grade students, regardless of ability or experience, are invited to join a sport at BCMS. Students must have a current physical on file (good for three years). Parents and students complete an online registration form. If students qualify for free or reduced lunches, they also qualify for free or reduced activity fees; this will appear on the online registration form.

To complement sports options, BCMS offers several student-driven intramural and club activities, designed strictly for fun and recreation! These activities are student driven and change every year based on student interest. Students participating in these activities do not compete against other schools.
