Ten schools serve over 5,000 students, whose test scores, at every grade level, significantly outpace state averages.

Abundant in-school and extracurricular opportunities instill creativity and encouraging students to aim high. In 2023, residents approved a \$41.5-million bond referendum to improve security, building integrity and operating efficiency. In 2019, residents also approved an operating referendum for an additional \$750 per student to help maintain the high-quality programs and services BHM Schools already offers.

EARLY LEARNING Options Begin at Birth

Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) serves families with children from newborn to kindergarten. Options include parent classes, parent/child classes, an annual family fair, summer events and preschool classes. Our ECFE preschool classes for children ages 3 to 5 have earned Minnesota Parent Aware's Four-Star Rating.

Special Education services are available at birth and can continue through age 22.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS Small Class Sizes, Abundant Options

BHM Schools takes pride in the number of opportunities offered to elementary-age students, who benefit from class sizes that are smaller than most surrounding districts, especially in grades K-2. Parkside, Hanover and Northwinds serve their respective neighborhoods. Families may choose Discovery with its multi-age/looping classrooms; Tatanka, offering a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) magnet program; or Montrose Elementary School of Innovation with a STEAM Magnet Program focus that includes the Arts. The Quest Program provides accelerated learning opportunities for the top 2-3% of students in grades 2-9, with grades 2-5 served at Parkside.

MIDDLE SCHOOL Small Groups, Big Opportunities

Buffalo Community Middle School students work collaboratively in grade-level teams to promote a small-group atmosphere in a school with big opportunities. All grade 6 students take coursework in technology, art and communication, taught through the lens of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math). AVID, Bison Binders and students' first-hour Prime Time class build organizational skills and improve academic performance. Students also benefit from top-notch music instructors, numerous vocal and instrumental options, and extracurricular choices in sports, academics and the arts.



Through the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum, Buffalo High School students earned more than **5,400 college credits** in 2023-24, a savings of more than **\$1.8 million** for families!

HIGH SCHOOL Preparing for Success

Buffalo High School offers regionally unmatched opportunities in academics, arts and athletics. More than 1,700 students in grades 9–12 have access to approximately 40 career-focused and college-level courses, which far exceeds what is available at most other districts. Thanks to a unique set of courses that align with the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum, students can graduate from BHS having completed nearly all the general education requirements for a four-year university – all without sacrificing the high school experience. In addition, **Phoenix Learning Center**, a schoolwithin-a-school located at Buffalo High School, serves students who thrive in an alternative high school setting.,


PRIDE TRANSITIONS Developing Skills for Independence

This specially designed instructional program for students with disabilities, ages 18-22, provides a transition from the high school environment to the community or post secondary education. Students access community resources as they focus on developing skills to meet education, training, employment and independent-living goals.
