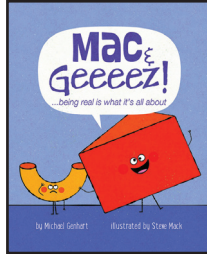
ECFE Classes & Activities

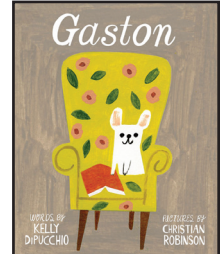
Mac and Geeeeez!

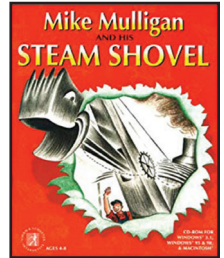
It's an Orange Aardvark!

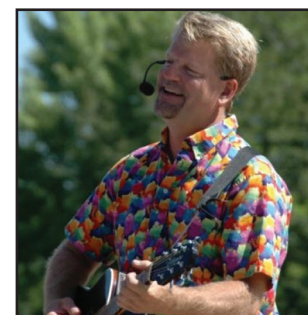


Teddy Bear Band, July 14
