Greetings BHM Families,

Effective February 25, 2022, the CDC exercised its enforcement discretion to not require that people wear masks on buses or vans operated by public or private school systems, including early care and education/child care programs. The CDC made this change to align with updated guidance that no longer recommends universal indoor mask wearing in K-12 schools and early education settings in areas with a low or medium COVID-19 Community Level.

In the revised guidance, the CDC clarifies that the TSA mask mandate for public transportation does not apply to public or private schools, including early care and education/child care programs. Therefore, masks will no longer be required on BHM buses, effective Monday, February 28th. BHM students, staff and bus drivers may wear masks on buses if they choose to do so.
